Research Repositories

- Research Repository Integration involves the complex mixture of metadata and full text files – share your experiences managing full text uploads
- Public data and private data – is there a consensus?
- Workflow processes range from a single approval step to a more complex check across multiple administrative groups. What have you learned about best practice?
- Non traditional outputs like Creative Works – is there common ground
- How are you managing “On Acceptance” deposit of Research Outputs. This is in relation to funding agencies requiring deposits from the time a publication is accepted by the Publisher.
- Open Access Policy – how it translates into system functionality
- Repository Platforms – DSpace, Fedora and EPrints
- Digital Collection Policy – is this a growth area or overkill?

Populating Research Profiles and other systems:

- API's and Reporting databases – how complex are your update routines and what works best for your institution?
- Formatting citation styles for Research Output types – do you have a foolproof solution? International Standards – do you comply and what is your view on the future

of global profiling

- Respect and Trust – does your institution value the metadata collections made available?
- Innovative solutions to technically vexing problems
- Data Warehouse solutions – survey of the space
- The one size fits all record – good idea or setting yourself up to fail?
